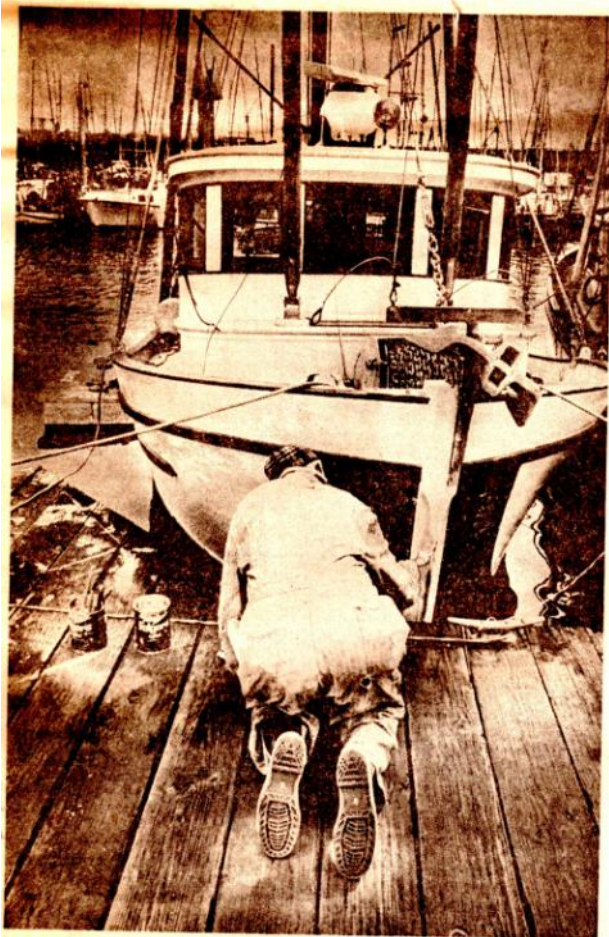

## Getting ship-shape

"IT'S a lot of work but you have to do it every year if you're going to keep the boat in shape." That's why O. K. Krueger, 64, was in all kinds of uncomfortable positions at Fishermen's Terminal the other day. He was getting the Carolyn Page—named after a niece—ready for the trolling season. Krueger, of 7 Highland Drive, has been fishing 20 years. A new burden

has been added to a livelihood that in recent years has been one of considerable economic risk. Trollers must fish outside the three-mile limit. But Krueger, all alone, next week will take the 36-foot Carolyn Page to the waters off LaPush—carrying with him the commercial fisherman's eternal hope for a good year.
